River/Rock Guide

Job Description:

The Guides at Windfall Rafting are the primary point of contact between Windfall Rafting and its guests. They ensure the safety of all guests, provide a fun rafting environment, and act as the conduit through which we convey the message of Christ to our guests.

Reports to: The General Manager, River Manager

Responsibilities:

Convey guests safely down the Kennebec and Dead rivers while creating a fun and adventurous environment.

Lead trips to Mt. Kenio while keeping groups safe, together, and happy. Belay for climbers and lifeguard for swimmers on these trips.

Be prepared to share a personal testimony for guests at some point in the day.

Participate in the upkeep of the raft base.

Be available to perform “night phone” duty at least once a week.

Meet regularly with the river manager to provide him or her feedback on rafting operations while also receiving feedback on job performance.

Ensure the safety of all guests on the river and during transit to and from the river.

If involved in “put in,” ensure that every necessary detail is attended to prior to leaving for put in.

Participate in meetings after each expedition to evaluate the team’s performance and to find ways to improve.

Check boat and equipment prior to putting in on every trip.

Recommended skills include: White Water Guiding Skills (including rescue techniques and instruction), Rock climbing (and belaying), paintball CO2 filling, Commercial Driver’s License recommended.
